3. To be familiar with the requirement to have evidence and records available as specified in the relevant scheme.
4. To refrain from any publicity of QCI project as long as the certificate has not been granted.
5. Not to file any suit or claim against QCI or the assessors for any monetary recoveries or for any other damages of any nature whatsoever, which the applicant suffers as a result of not granting the certificate or as a result of the failure by QCI in dealing with this application, for the reasons beyond the control of QCI.
6. To agree that the growers shall be fully liable to the QCI in any respect if QCI is prevented from discharging such obligation arising out of this application.
7. Disputes if any arising out of this application between QCI and the applicant arising out of the terms and conditions of the application form and the letter of offer submitted by QCI shall be resolved through arbitration wherein SG, QCI shall be the final appellate.
8. Agree that monies paid to experts for capacity building and/or certification costs under this application shall be refunded by the applicant should the entity abort or not support QCI in the stipulated years of handholding/certification.
9. To comply with any additional requirements as may be stipulated or required by QCI based on the scheme requirements/project requirements being assessed.
